



## What is a CESSWI?

A CESSWI is a recognized specialist in soil erosion, sediment control and storm water inspection. The certification program, sponsored by the Soil and Water Conservation Society and the International Erosion Control Association, provides the public with evidence of professional qualifications. This designation is given to specialists who have met established standards of expertise, experience and knowledge.

A CESSWI must demonstrate through education, experience and examination, knowledge of various inspection methods related to soil erosion, and storm water controls for construction activities.

The CESSWI program is designed for individuals involved in the following E&SC and storm water inspection activities:

- ◆ Installation and inspection of E&SC practices
- ◆ Installation and inspection of storm water controls
- ◆ Related activities (such as, assisting regulators, authoring handbooks, and educating the public).

- ◆ Promote public awareness of the erosion and sediment control profession.
